STODDAY, LANCASTER) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2018**

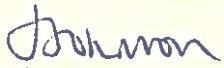
This Order is made by Lancashire County Council (the "Authority") under Section 53(2)(b) and 53(3)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that Authority that The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) namely the discovery by the Surveying Authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, namely a restricted byway.

The Authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. Lancashire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order, the relevant date is 3rd October 2018.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Lancashire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Lancashire County Council (Aldcliffe Hall Drive, Aldcliffe With Stodday, Lancaster) Definitive Map Modification Order 2018.

SCHEDULE

PART I

MODIFICATION OF THE DEFINITIVE MAP

DESCRIPTION OF PATH OR WAY TO BE ADDED

A restricted byway known as Aldcliffe Hall Drive from Aldcliffe Road adjacent to Lancaster Canal (at point A on the Order Map), through stone gateposts and passing East Lodge to ascend gently uphill in a generally south westerly direction along the driveway and passing Ashlar House and Ashlar Lodge to concrete posts at point B. From point B the route continues in a south south westerly direction with properties along either side to meet Aldcliffe Hall Lane at point C. The total length of the route is 230 metres with a width varying between 3 and 9 metres, to include footways in some sections. The entire route is shown between points A and C of the Order Map with a dashed green line.

MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT

VARIATION OF PARTICULARS OF PATH OR WAY

Add to the Definitive Statement for Lancaster the following:
Lancaster 64:

No. of Path: "64"

Kind of Path: "Restricted Byway"

Position: "Restricted byway known as Aldcliffe Hall Drive from Aldcliffe Road adjacent to Lancaster Canal at SD 4694 6040 passing through stone gateposts at East Lodge to ascend gently uphill in a general south westerly direction along Aldcliffe Hall Drive to concrete posts at SD 4673 6028 and continuing in a south south westerly direction with properties along either side to meet Aldcliffe Hall Lane at SD 4660 6016. All compass directions given are approximate."

Width: Varying between 3 and 9 metres including footways in some sections.

Limitations: None

Length: 0.23km



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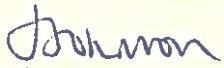
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
