(LOWER ANTLEY STREET, ACCRINGTON HYNDBURN BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Lower Antley Street, Accrington between Sidings Way and Barlow Street for 40 metres.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0730 to 1700 hours on Monday 6th April 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to temporarily close the footpsth between Sidings Way and Barlow Street for 40 metres and take use of the blocked section of Lower Antley Street.
