

NOTICE OF MAKING
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL(VARIOUS ROADS, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING 25-26 (NO1F)) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 9th July 2026 Lancashire County Council made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- a) Blackburn Road, Ribchester, the north side, from a point 17.5 metres west of its junction with the Centreline of Ribblesdale Road for a distance of 27 metres in an easterly direction;
- b) Ribblesdale Road, Ribchester, the east side, from its junction with the Centreline of Blackburn Road for a distance of 21.5 metres in a northerly direction;
- c) Ribblesdale Road, Ribchester, the west side, from its junction with the Centreline of Blackburn Road for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

This Order will come into force on the 24th July 2026. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
