(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

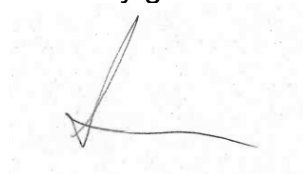
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. Clover Road, Chorley from its junction with Butterworth Brow, Chorley for a distance of 143 metres in a northerly direction.
 - II. Lydgate, Chorley from its junction with Clover Road, Chorley for a distance of 27 metres in an easterly direction.
 - III. Butterworth Brow, Chorley from its junction with Clover Road, Chorley for a distance of 30 metres in either direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 1800 hours until 0600 hours on Wednesday 26th August 2026 until Saturday 29th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via

Lydgate – Liptrott Road - B5251 Moor Road - B5251 Coppull Road and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow sewer and lining works to be carried out.
