(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Queens Road and Penny House Lane from Whalley Road to Burnley Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force daily from 0600 hours to 1800 hours on Tuesday 2nd June 2026 to Tuesday 14th July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibition will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be via- main diversion Penny House Lane – Burnley Road – Eastgate – Hyndburn Road – Dunkenhalgh Way – Blackburn Road – Whalley Road
Local diversion Queens Road West – Moss Hall Lane – Clifton Avenue – Lime Road – Marlborough Road 0 Garden Street – Fosters Street and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway re surfacing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
