(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

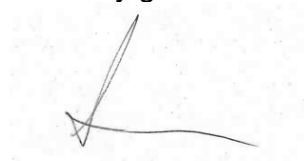
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway;
 - I. B5250 Lydiate Lane, Eccleston from its junction with A581 Southport Road, Eccleston to its merging with B5250 Towngate, Eccleston.
 - II. B5250 Towngate, Eccleston from its merging with B5250 Lydiate Lane, Eccleston for a distance of 145 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0900 hours until 1500 hours on Wednesday 7th October 2026 until Friday 9th October 2026 or until completion of the works within this period. **The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

B5250 Towngate - B5250 The Green - B5250 Langton Brow - B5250 Wood Lane – Park Hall Road – Mill Lane - A49 Preston Road - A49 Sibbering Brow - A49 Wigan Road - A581 Dawbers Lane - A581 Southport Road and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway pre-surface dressing patching works to be carried out.
