(PEMBROKE AVENUE, COLWYN AVENUE, ST MARGARETS ROAD,
CLIFFORD AVENUE, MORECAMBE, LANCASTER CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over those lengths of
 - i. **Pembroke Avenue, Morecambe** from its junction with St Christophers Way to its junction with Stuart Street.
 - ii. **Colwyn Avenue, Morecambe** from its junction with Pembroke Avenue to its junction with Clifford Avenue.
 - iii. **St Margarets Road, Morecambe** from its junction with Marine Road East to its junction with Clifford Avenue.
 - iv. **Clifford Avenue, Morecambe** from its junction with St Margarets Road to its junction with Seaborn Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours until 1800 hours on Wednesday 8th July 2026 until Tuesday 14th July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Emergency services access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
