

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(ADMARSH DRIVE AND MILESTONE DRIVE AREAS, GREAT ECCLESTON, WYRE BOROUGH)
(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Speed Limit Order under Section 84 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit in the following lengths of road:

- a) Admarsh Drive, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- b) Brockholes Avenue, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- c) Dovecote Close, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- d) Forton Place, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- e) Greenhalgh Close, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- f) Kiln Avenue, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- g) Milestone Drive, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- h) Pinfold Close, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- i) Porters Grove, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- j) Seedling Place, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- k) St Annes Avenue, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- l) Tarngate Mews, Great Eccleston, the entire length;
- m) Willow Close, Great Eccleston, the entire length.
