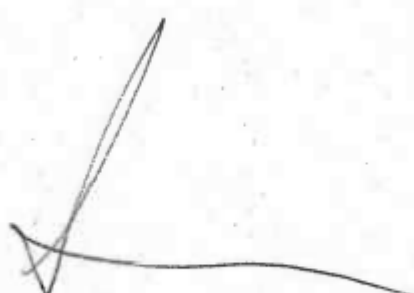
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Scriffen Lane, Ellel from its junction with Sandy Lane to its junction with Bay Horse Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2026 until 1630 hours on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access for emergency services will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
By Horse Road – Stoney Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow North Star Estates Ltd to install new low voltage main connection to Telecoms Mast be carried out on behalf of Electricity North West.
