Re: Modification to Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way

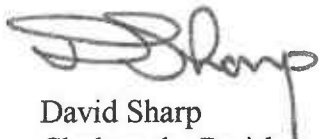
West Bradford Parish Council is seeking to have the footpath to the rear of Millbrook Court declared a public right of way shown on the definitive map of the area.

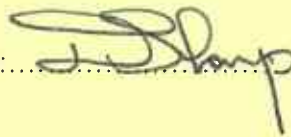
